### GENERAL INFORMATION

QUICKWATER is a proprietary blend of soil surfactants designed to facilitate the uniform movement of water into and throughout the soil profile. QUICKWATER contains penetrants that reduce the surface tension of water, allowing quick movement through mat and thatch, reducing standing water and runoff. Additional surfactant technologies contained in QUICKWATER provide longer residual, effectively controlling localized dry spots for up to 90 days. QUICKWATER may be used either curatively or preventively, making it a useful tool in turf management programs.

QUICKWATER MAY BE USED ON GOLF COURSES, ATHLETIC FIELDS AND RESIDENTIAL OR COMMERCIAL TURF.

### DIRECTIONS FOR USE

For best results follow application rates and mixing instructions below. Always mix and apply QUICKWATER in accordance with the instructions found on the pesticide label regarding adjuvants. In the absence of specific instructions, follow the application and mixing guidelines below.

### APPLICATION TECHNIQUES

QUICKWATER does not require irrigation after application. However, watering after the application will improve results by moving the product from the leaf blade and into the soil. If irrigation is not planned prior to mowing, remove mower baskets to avoid product loss. In situations where tank mix partners achieve maximum efficacy by remaining on the leaf blade, irrigation should be delayed as specified on the tank mix partner's label. During periods of high temperature, all soil surfactants should be watered in to increase performance and safety.

### APPLICATION RATES AND INTERVALS

Apply QUICKWATER at the rate of 4 to 6 ounces, in a minimum of 1 gallon of water, per 1000 square feet of turfgrass for curative control of localized dry spot, or when 30 days of control are required.

Apply QUICKWATER at the rate of 8 to 12 ounces, in a minimum of 1 gallon of water, per 1000 square feet of turfgrass for preventative control of localized dry spot, or when up to 90 days of control is required.

### MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Unless prior experience has proven the combination of products to be effective, compatible and safe on the desired turf species, it is recommended that QUICKWATER be applied to a small area of turf to determine results, prior to a large-scale application. When tank mixing QUICKWATER, add the products to the spray tank in the following order: 1) Products in water-soluble bags (agitate and allow bags to completely dissolve before adding any other products); 2) Water dispersible granules (WDG) and wettable powders (WP); 3) QUICKWATER; 4) Spray markers; 5) Flowable liquids or suspension concentrates; 6) Emulsifiable concentrates.

### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Protect product from freezing. If product freezes, warm to room temperature before use. Store in original container only and do not reuse empty container. Rinse container thoroughly, disposing of rinsate and the container in accordance with federal, state and local regulations. Do not store near heat or open flame.
